Pinot Grigio is the second most popular white wine in America. Pinot Grigio is a white wine grape variety of the species *Vitis Vinifera*. Thought to be a mutant clone of the Pinot Noir variety, the grapes have a brownish pink to black and even white appearance.

Our Pinot Grigio has aromas of honey-suckle that soar into pear and apple flavors on the pallet. This Pinot Grigio offers a refreshing twinkly of acidity and a weighted feeling on the middle of your tongue.
